 Establish a multi-year, sustainable, resourcing strategy to provide additional funding for essential police services.





Community Resource Team (CRT) Process

- Jan. 2016: Council Workshop VPD Update by Chief McElvain.
- Apr. 2016: CRT convened. Meetings facilitated by Anne Pressentin, Envirolssues.
- Apr. Nov. 2016: Nine CRT meetings. Extensive discussions and review of data, budgets, reports, public feedback.
- Dec. 2016: CRT recommendation completed. City Council Workshop.





Revenue Package - Elements

The following funding elements are included in the funding package:

- Marijuana sales tax revenues (2017)
- COPS grant funding (2017)
- Proposed Van Mall North annexation tax revenues (2017)
- Increase Business License FTE Surcharge (2017)
- Increase Utility Tax Rate on City-owned utilities (2017)
- Annual surcharge on multi-family units (2019)
- Annual sq. ft. surcharge on retail, commercial and industrial space (2019)



Public Hearing Today

Council is asked to vote on the following items:

- Business License Surcharge Changes:
 - Increase Business License FTE Surcharge by \$20 per FTE (2017)
 - Implement Annual surcharge on multi-family units (2019)
 - Implement Annual sq. ft. surcharge on retail, commercial and industrial space (2019)
- Increase Utility Tax on City-owned utilities (2017) and increase the underlying utility rates to allow for the increase in the Utility Tax

New Funding Elements – Contingent Repealer Provision

- Provision for a repeal of the Multi-Family Unit Surcharge and Surcharge on Retail,
 Commercial and Industrial space if:
 - An alternative funding option is approved that provides sufficient funding for the police service level increases recommended in the CRT report; and,
 - The new funding option becomes effective prior to January 1, 2019.
