

Josiah Alanis, Evergreen

Junior set a 3A state meet record to win long jump title (24 feet, 1 inch) in his second year of track and field.

Ethan Linerud, Camas

Senior broke discus school record (172-7) to win the 4A state title. School's first boys discus champ in 22 years.

Juan Pasillas-Stanton, Mt. View

Junior was runnerup at 3A state meet in the shot put (59-6). Had the state's second-best mark in all classifications.



Adam Williams, Hudson's Bay

Senior league, district champion at 400 meters placed fourth at 2A state meet with first sub-50-second time (49.85).









Joe Callerame, Seton Catholic Junior had personal-best 184-3 in the javelin to place fourth at 1A state meet.

Chase McGee, Camas

Junior won 4A pole vault state title at 16-6, a height tied for third-best all-time at state across all classifications.

Davis Sullivan, Ridgefield

Junior placed eighth at 2A state meet in 800 (1:57.47). Time achieved in state prelims ranks tops in region (1:57.12).

Tucker Wyninger, Stevenson

No 1A pole vaulter matched the senior's top height of 14-6. Won 1A state title and placed eighth in 110 hurdles.







Will Foster, Prairie

Junior won 3A shot put state title with an all-classificationbest (59-7.75). Also finished second at state in the discus.

Jacob McManus, Columbia River

Junior set personalbest times at the 2A state meet with a pair of runner-up finishes: 1,600 (4:11.10) and 3,200 (9:06.80).

Koynn Williamdyke, R.A. Long

Senior captured 2A 300 hurdles state title (39.75). One of four 2A hurdlers statewide with sub-40-second times.
